

Meeting was called to order by President Susan Keeton at 5:35 P.M.

Becky Thompson, Treasurer, starting balance was \$9442.32. We had payouts for Orphan Annie, Benefit Tournament donations and website. We had income for 4 new memberships and tournaments, leaving a total balance of \$9724.17. We will have payouts for GHIN system, which will deplete balance some. Treasurer's report was approved with motions made and seconded by Sherry Kingsbury and Susann Briggs.

Play Day Chair, Jackie Kranz, indicated participation was extremely low. If anyone has any suggestions regarding increasing participation, would be appreciated. The sign-up sheet is in the bathroom to sign up for birdies, hole in ones, ride share, if you are participating in playing East Texas, B&B or some other tournament.
