

HLWGA MINUTES JUNE 24, 2026

Meeting was called to order by President Keeton at 5:30 p.m.

She introduced Lindsay Causey, GM, and new Golf Shop Pro, Chase Castloo. Ileana announced that ladies' apparel purchases in the Pro Shop would be reduced by 30%.

Social Chair, Nancy Briggs, had nothing at present, but was working on things and would let us know.

Fund Raising Chair, Becky Gowan, indicated that we will start selling tickets for the Association Dues, our main fund raiser next month. She indicated she knew she was not her favorite person but would appreciate everyone taking tickets and selling them. They will be in envelopes with five bundles, five tickets in each bundle. Drawing will be November 14.

She also told Chase that if he had anything, to please send it to Lyndsay.

Old business Margo Dowell, wanted to discuss the forward tees, in regards to fairness to all players. This mainly as related to the Scrambles. Our by-laws do not state which tees. That, however, would be up to play day chair, Jackie Kranz and Chase. It was decided that we could work this out whatever we had to do. Further discussion will be held, but at the present time, for July and August on play day we are leaving as is and it was felt that Chase and the pro shop would make it fair for everyone. Susan reiterated that 36 was maximum handicap was used in tournaments, as written in our by-laws. Chase explained the criteria for playing from the forward tees, using course handicap, GHIN handicap or GHIN index. He stated that the system is not perfect but we can work with it to make it fair. The GHIN system does have the course rated from the forward tees.

Jackie forgot earlier, but Nancy Briggs had a Birdie and presented her with her pin. No. 4 on June 10, 2026.

Sharon Brown, owner of the Fashion and Gossip Parlor advised that if you still have pro shop credit but could find nothing you were crazy about, if you would bring it to the shop she would put a tag on it and proceeds would be distributed.
